



GIFT WRAPPING TECHNIQUES



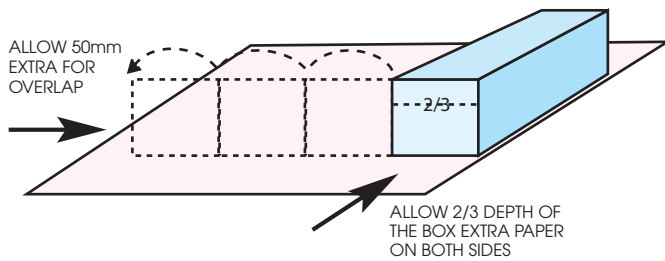
The key to wrapping the perfect present is:

- Always use good quality wrapping paper.
- Cut the paper to the correct size (too much paper creates a badly wrapped present.)
- Wrap your present firmly, and sharply crease edges and corners for a professional finish.
- Have fun and be creative with your wrapping, you will enjoy it and so will the gift recipient.

EQUIPMENT:

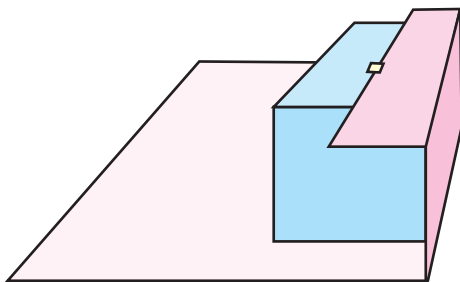
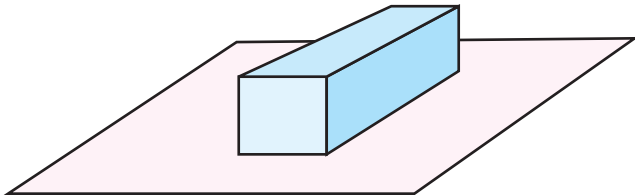
- A good pair of sharp scissors
- Good quality STICKY TAPE
(cheap tape comes unstuck)

1 LAY THE BOX ON THE WRAPPING PAPER AND ROLL ACROSS THE PAPER THREE TIMES, ADDING 50mm OVERLAP. USING SCISSORS CUT WRAPPING PAPER TO THIS LENGTH.

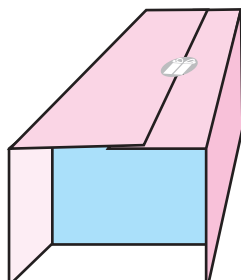


2 CUT THE WIDTH OF THE WRAPPING PAPER ALLOWING 2/3 THE DEPTH OF THE BOX EXTRA ON EACH SIDE.

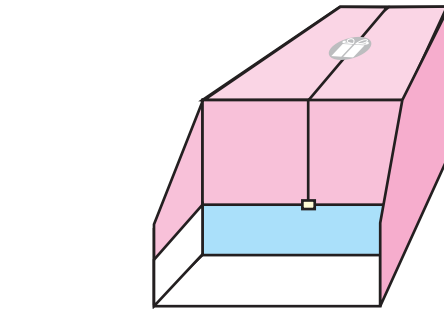
3 PLACE THE BOX IN THE CENTRE OF THE PAPER UPSIDE DOWN.



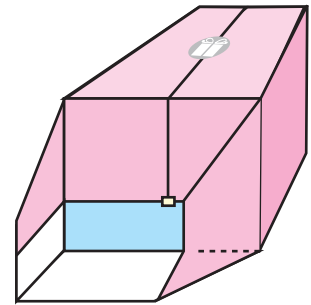
4 BRING THE RIGHT HAND EDGE OF THE PAPER TO THE CENTRE OF THE PRESENT.



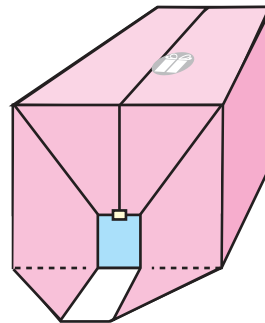
5 REPEAT TO THE LEFT HAND SIDE OF THE PRESENT, OVERLAPPING THE RIGHT HAND SIDE PAPER BY 50MM. SECURE WITH A FOIL GIFT SEAL OR STICKY TAPE.



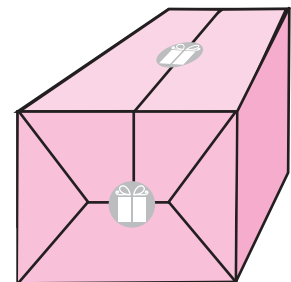
6 FOLD DOWN THE TOP FLAP AND SECURE WITH STICKY TAPE. CREASE THE SIDE FLAPS NEATLY INTO THE CORNERS.



7 FIRMLY CREASE AND FOLD SIDE FLAP INWARDS TO CENTRE.



8 HOLDING FOLDED SIDE END FLAP IN PLACE, CREASE AND FOLD THE LEFT SIDE



9 CREASE AND FOLD UP THE BOTTOM FLAP. SECURE WITH A FOIL GIFT SEAL OR STICKY TAPE.

10 REPEAT STEPS 6 TO 9 ON THE OPPOSITE END OF THE PRESENT.
